## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO UPHILL TOURING INFO & POLICY

**OPERATIONAL  
TOURING HOURS:**  
8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m.

**NON-OPERATIONAL  
TOURING HOURS:**  
5 p.m. - 8:30 a.m.

**Upper/Lower Warren's Way is closed to touring due to winch cat operations. STAY AWAY.**

No dogs allowed during operational hours.

Uphillers are required to wear snowshoes or touring skis/split boards with metal edges and brakes or restraint straps. During operation you must descend on skis or snowboard, you cannot descend on snowshoes.

Skiers' responsibility code applies at all times.

Please use wilderness etiquette: remove all human/dog waste and leave only tracks.

Always ascend single file, skiers right on the side of designated trail. Downhill skiers have right away.

**STAY AWAY FROM ALL RESORT OPERATIONS AND MACHINERY. ANY TRAIL WITH ACTIVE SNOWMAKING OR GROOMING OPERATIONS IN PROGRESS IS CLOSED TO ALL UPHILL OR DOWNHILL TRAVEL.**

**Ski Patrol Services are available from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. daily.** For all accidents that occur outside of operating times call 911.

No unauthorized motorized vehicles are permitted on ski trails; violators will be prosecuted.
